DATE AND VENUE

Regatta will take place on 14-15 July 2018 on the water of the Gulf of Gdańsk.

1. RULES

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Current Racing Rules of Sailing WD 2017-2020 edition, COLREG 1972, the order of the President of PoZŻ about the functioning of the Regatta Technical Commission of 17/05/2017 (based on OSR category 4), ORC and KWR Rating System Rule, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.
Regatta has a license of the Polish Sailing Association.
Regatta sailing event is dedicated to amateur sailors.
In the regatta there is an inspection card of the boat equipment PoZŻ pattern in the range appropriate for the Gulf of Gdansk extended by points 4.04.1 and 5.02.1.a.

2. ATTENDANCE, CLASSES, GROUP DIVISION

Every sea boat capable of sailing in the racing area can take part in the regatta.
The regatta will include the following classes:
- ORC (Club and International)
- KWR - for boats without the ORC certificate
- OPEN - for boats without any certificates only

The Leonid Teliga Memorial will be awarded in the ORC and KWR classes.
The Polish Championships will be held in the ORC class, for a separate (within the ORC class) subgroup (division) of yachts with the ORC International certificate.

The boat may be qualified only into the one class.
There will not be group division.

3. ENTRY FEE

Entry fee until 6 July is PLN 70.
Entry fee from 7 July is PLN 140.

4. ENTRIES AND REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS

The following documents are required: third party liability insurance, payment confirmation, signed application. In ORC class signed, valid ORC certificate is required.

Applications should be made by filling out the application form available at Organizer's website, www.jkmgryf.pl.

The notification is effective when the yacht immediately appears on the list of entries on the Organizer's website. In addition, upon completion of the application, a confirmation with further instructions of procedure will be automatically sent to the e-mail address provided in the application,. If this does not happen, please contact the Organizer.

For yachts competing in the Polish Championships, the deadline for entries is 30 June.
For other yachts, the deadline is 12 July.

The admission of the yacht to the regatta, and placement on the starting list, will take place after delivery of the required documents to the regatta office and a successful passage of the class inspection (not applicable to the OPEN class) and security.

The required documents should be delivered to the Organizer within the deadline of July 13 to 19:00 (email, in person). On July 13, the regatta office will be open from 16:00 to 19:00.

5. SCHEDULE

Friday, 13th July.

Control measurements and inspections between 8:00 and 19:00.

Final confirmation of entries and review of documents between 16:00 and 19:00.

Posting the start list after 19:00.

The mandatory captain's briefing will take place on July 14 at 08:30 at the Organizer's place.

Three races are planned.

The races will be held on:

a) Saturday, July 14, 2018

First race - 10:00

Second race - 15 min. after finishing the first race by the last boat.

b) Sunday, 15 July 2018

Third race - 10:00

On this day, the start signal will not be given after 13:00.

The announcement of the results and awarding ceremony is planned for July 15 at 14:00 at the Organizer's office.

The ceremony may be delayed due to conditions on the water.

Detailed information about the ending ceremony will be given in a separate message.

6. MEASUREMENTS, PLACE OF STANDING, LIMITATIONS

The condition for admitting the boat to the regatta is to undergo a control inspection.

The measurement day is Friday, 13 July. From the morning, boats should be available in Gdynia for control measurements and inspections.

During the regatta, control measurements of equipment and equipment specified in the regatta and class regulations may be made.

Between races, yachts can not be stationed outside the regatta port.

Yachts can not be removed from the water and can not repair the underwater part (also with the help of work boats and divers) without the written consent of the Race Committee and under the conditions specified there.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTION

The sailing instructions will be available on the regatta website and in the regatta office on 13 July.

8. SCORING

Yachts will be ranked:

- after conversion according to ORC formula
- after conversion according to KWR formula
- without conversion in OPEN class

ORC classification results will be calculated using the PCS method.

Final results will be calculated according to the low point rule.

9. PRIZES

The title of the International Polish Single Handed ORC Championship will be awarded to the winner of the International division in the ORC class.

For the second and third places in the ORC Int division, titles of the first and second Polish vice champion will be given.

The Leonid Teliga Memorial prize and the financial prize are given to yachts classified first after conversion according to ORC and separately according to KWR.

Winner, 2nd and 3rd places - after ORC conversion - financial prize

Winner, 2nd and 3rd places - after KWR conversion - financial prize

Winner in OPEN group - financial prize

Detailed information about the prizes will be provided in the Prize Regulations.

10. INSURANCE AND DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500,000 EUR per event.

11. FURTHER INFORMATION

Participating boats do not pay any mooring fee in Marina Gdynia yacht harbour.
